PREAMBLE Al-Hikmah University, Ilorin-Nigeria was established and licensed by the Federal Government of Nigeria to operate as a Conventional Private University in January, 2005. The University provides qualitative education with strong moral conduct without discrimination on the basis of nationality, age, gender, political or religious belief. It has accreditation by the National Universities Commission (NUC) for all its due academic programmes.

The University invites applications from suitably qualified candidates who score above 140 for admission into its academic programmes through the JAMB Unified Tertiary Matriculation Examination (U.T.M.E), Direct Entry and Inter-University Transfer.

All Full-time undergraduate programmes run for 4 academic sessions except Law which runs for (5 academic sessions), Sandwich Degree Programmes (5 contact sessions) and Part-Time undergraduate programmes (6 contact sessions). **Part-Time/Sandwich options are programmes marked with an asterisk (*).**

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

1. UNDERGRADUATE AND JUPEB PROGRAMMES

Applicants must possess a minimum of five (5) credits in WASSCE/NECO/GCE/NABTEB/SISC Examinations or their equivalents at not more than two (2) sittings in the subjects relevant to their proposed Undergraduate and JUPEB (Joint University Preliminary Examination Board) Programmes. English Language at credit level is compulsory for all candidates. In addition, a credit pass in Mathematics is compulsory for candidates seeking admission into Degree Programmes in the Faculties of Health Sciences, Management Sciences, Natural and Applied Sciences, and some Education Courses.

2. SUB-DEGREE (DIPLOMA) PROGRAMMES

Applicants are required to have a minimum of four (4) Credit passes at not more than two (2) sittings in the relevant subjects in WASSCE/NECO/GCE/NABTEB/SISC. Thanawiyah/Tawjihiyah Certificate of any Arabic Senior Secondary School duly registered with the relevant State Authorities or equivalent to any of the above-mentioned qualifications will be considered.

Applicants for the Sub-degree Law Diploma Programmes must possess five (5) credits in WASSCE/NECO/GCE/NABTEB/SISC Examinations or their equivalents at not more than two (2) sittings, including English Language, Literature-in-English and any other three (3) Art/Social science subjects, and at least a pass in Mathematics. Applicants for Common Law (Common and Islamic Law) must, in addition, have a credit pass in Islamic Studies or Arabic.

3. SANDWICH DEGREE PROGRAMMES

Applicants are required to have a minimum of five (5) credits in WASSCE/NECO/GCE/NABTEB/SISC Examinations or their equivalents at not more than two (2) sittings for Contact One (1), while applicants with ND/NCE/HND certificate are admissible into Contact Session Two (2).

3. POSTGRADUATE PROGRAMMES

(i) Postgraduate Diploma (PGD): Applicants must possess a first degree from Al-Hikmah University Ilorin, or any other recognised University. Holders of Higher National Diploma (HND) are also eligible.

(ii) Master's Degree: Applicants for the academic Master's Degree programmes who are graduates of Al-Hikmah University, Ilorin, or any other recognised university, must possess a minimum of Second Class Honours Degree (Lower Division) provided they score a minimum of 50% in the qualifying examination to be administered by the University.

(iii) M.Phil.: Applicants for the M.Phil Programme must possess a minimum of Second Class Honours Degree (Lower Division) or 3rd Class Honour Degree with additional postgraduate degree or 5 years work experience in relevant disciplines.

(iv) Ph.D.: Applications must possess a Master's degree with a CGPA of at least 3.5 on a 5.0 point scale, 3.0 on a 4.0 point scale or M.Phil. degree and must demonstrate adequate intellectual capacity, maturity and effective decision-making and problem-solving potentials.

ALL CANDIDATES shall apply early and submit their previous degree(s) academic transcripts to The Dean, Postgraduate School, Al-Hikmah University, Ilorin.

METHOD OF APPLICATION

He therefore, implored the Management to continue to extend

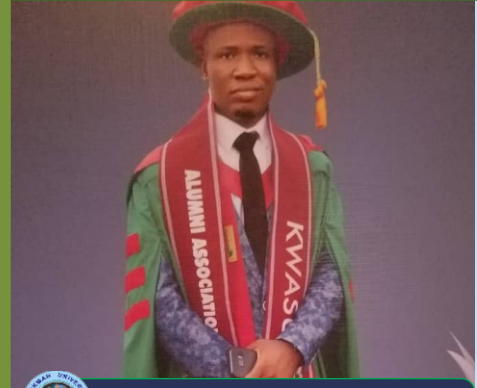


A Cross section of Al-Hikmah, University Students with the Organizer

DEAN OF PG SCHOOL ADVISES ON RELEVANCE OF RESEARCH



The Dean of Postgraduate School, Al-Hikmah University, Prof. Joshua Olaniyan Fazoranti, has advised lecturers to assist their

postgraduate students to make their researches meet international standard in order to be relevant to the society. Prof. Fazoranti, who was at the just-concluded Committee of Deans of Postgraduate Schools (CDPGS) of Nigeria Conference held recently at the Rivers State University, Port-Harcourt, between 28th April and 1st May, 2019, explained that the issue of research was among the critical issues that were deliberated upon at the Conference. In his words, "Postgraduate students should take their courses seriously and they should know the difference between research and long essay. Research should also be original and should not be plagiarised." The Dean added that research is crucial to national development, and universities should be made to be centres to proffer solutions to socio-economic challenges. Hence, Federal Government should give adequate funding to universities, especially Private Universities. Prof. Fazoranti reiterated that the standard of education was the main reason Nigerians crave for overseas education. He added that the turnout of students for postgraduate courses in Nigeria is not encouraging. He, therefore, advised the Federal Government to invest more in education and research.

HUI COMES 3RD IN AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF PETROLEUM GEOLOGISTS COMPETITION

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Omobolanle, a final year student of the Department of Chemical and Geological Sciences of the University, stated that she was thrilled by the experience because she had never participated in such a competition before.

Feyisetan added that their lecturers took their time and resources to prepare them for the competition. She,

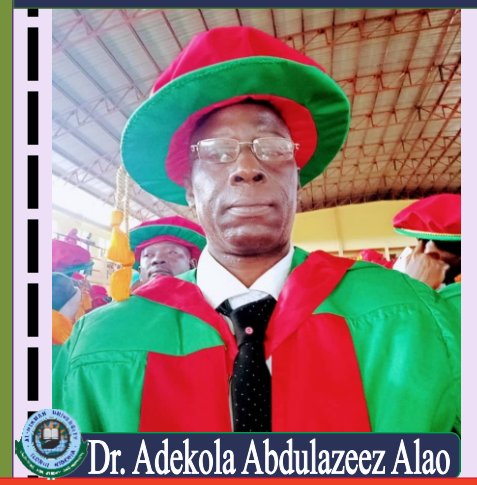
however, regretted that they could not emerge first in the competition.
