The Founder, however, admonished consultants' and contractors on the need to utilize available resources in the execution of the projects to meet desired standard.

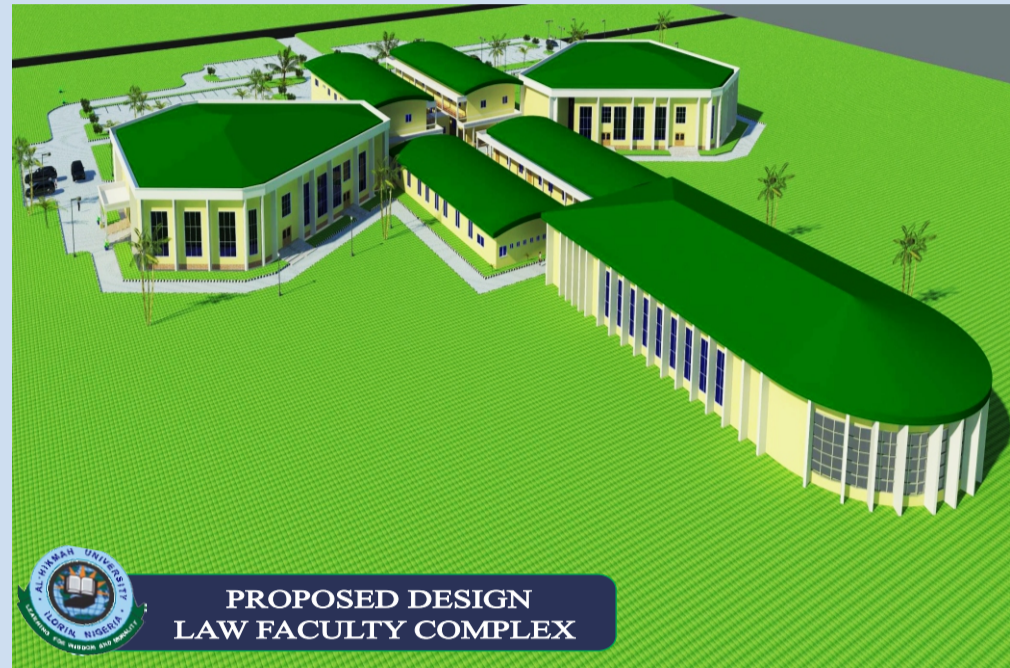

The award which was given by the Nigerian Society of Mining Engineers (NSME) was in appreciation of his contribution to national development.

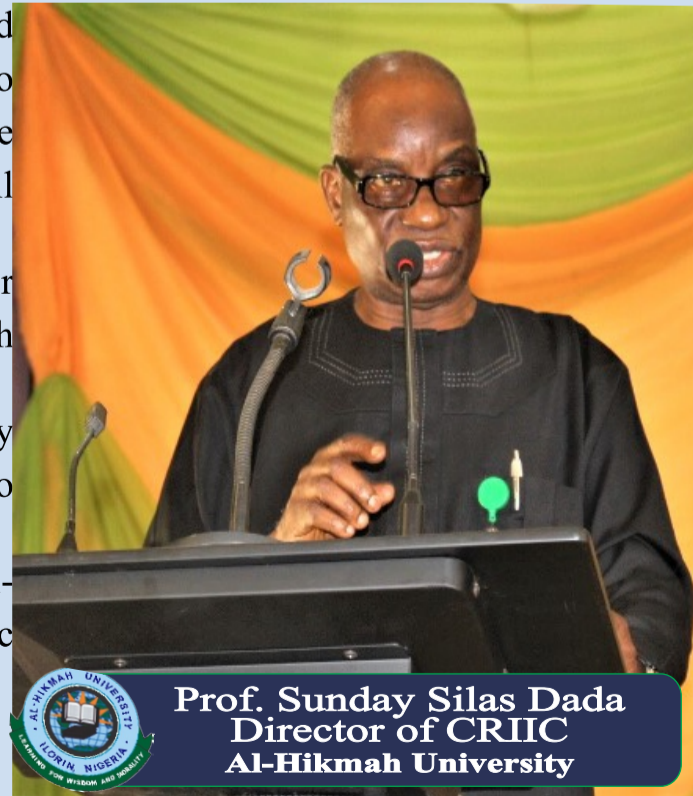
