



AGRICULTURE: HUI COUNCIL CHAIRMAN CHARGES MANAGEMENT, STAFF TO BE PRODUCTIVE

The management and staff of Al-Hikmah University, Ilorin has been charged to make the best use of 200 hectares of land designated for agriculture at its Igbaja campus.

The Pro-Chancellor and Chairman of Council of the institution Dr. Muhammed Dikko Abubakar gave the charge during his visitation to the campus.

Commending the management for the establishment of the farm, the former Inspector General of Police, noted that with proper management of the farm the University would be highly self-sustaining.

He directed that the gestation period for the

farm self-sustaining status should be one year after which the salaries, maintenance of Igbaja campus staff can be paid and start providing a percentage of its profit for the university's development.

The Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Taofeek Ibrahim disclosed that poultry farming was planned to start by December, 2019 after the 9th convocation held on Saturday.

He assured the Chairman that the farm would serve the food needs of the communities within and outside Kwara State urging staff to put in their best in all facets of activities of HUI.

Conducting the team round Igbaja Campus, the representative of the Faculty of Agriculture, Mr. Saheed Adeyemi said feed meal



production would also commence immediately on a large commercial scale.

He showed the team the feed meal machine that consists of three components (mixer, crusher and conveyor) and other facilities in the campus.
